Overview:

The Namibian Chamber of Environment (NCE) considers the investment in building capacity and skills in young, previously disadvantaged Namibians as one of the most important aspects of its work. This involves two components: (a) bursaries for promising, self-motivated students at Honours and Masters levels, combined with (b) good quality mentorship by prominent professionals who involve the students in their ongoing work and who give significant amounts of time to the students. To this end, the NCE has set up a burasy and mentorship programme, and we are delighted that the Woodtiger Fund(US) has joined hands with us to significantly increase the impact of this initiative.

The selection criteria:

The NCE received a total of 45 bursary applications. During the selection process, we prepared and used an evaluation form and scored the applicants based on:

- Field of study
- Academic achievements to date
- **Financial need**
- Leadership potential and demonstrated achievements
