The Conservation Status and Red List of the Terrestrial Carnivores of Namibia has now been published. This publication, also known as the Carnivore Red Data Book, provides the latest scientific information on the conservation status of Namibia's 34 terrestrial carnivore species.

This joint publication between the Ministry of Environment, Forestry and Tourism (MEFT), the Large Carnivore Management Association of Namibia (LCMAN) and the Namibian Chamber of Environment (NCE), involved 25 expert species assessors, 30 contributors and 31 reviewers.
